ORDINANCE 2025-730-E

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE \$100,000 IN GRANT FUNDS ORIGINALLY APPROPRIATED BY ORDINANCE 2024-767-E TO EL BETHEL DIVINE HOLINESS CHURCH, INC. D/B/A EL BETH EL DEVELOPMENT CENTER, INC. ("EL BETH FOR THE PEOPLE HELPING PEOPLE PREVENTION PROGRAM TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2026, SO THE FUNDS REMAIN AVAILABLE FOR DISBURSEMENT TO EL BETH EL; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 CITY TO THEAGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND EL BETH EL (THE "AGREEMENT") TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT TO MARCH 31, 2026, AND CERTAIN OTHER RELATED DATES AND DEADLINES WITHIN THE REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2024-767-E, the City Council appropriated \$100,000 in grant funding and authorized execution of a grant agreement with El Bethel Divine Holiness Church, Inc. d/b/a El Beth El Development Center, Inc. ("El Beth El") for the People Helping People Crime Prevention Program (the "Program") in fiscal year 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, the Council subsequently enacted Ordinance 2025-482-E to authorize disbursement of the full amount of the grant funds as an advance payment to El Beth El recognizing that all Program events being funded through the City grant had already occurred; and WHEREAS, a portion of the funds appropriated to El Beth El for the Program have not been disbursed and the Council desires to ensure these funds remain available in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 for distribution in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 City Grant Agreement between the City and El Beth El (the "Agreement"); now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Carryover. The remaining portion of the \$100,000 originally appropriated by Ordinance 2024-767-E for a grant to El Beth El for the People Helping People Crime Prevention Program shall not lapse but shall carryover to September 30, 2026, so the funds remain available for distribution to El Beth El in accordance with the Agreement.

Section 2. Authorizing Execution of Amendment to Agreement.

The Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the Agreement originally approved and authorized by Ordinance 2024-767-E and amended by Ordinance 2025-482-E, to extend the term of the agreement to March 31, 2026, and certain other related dates and deadlines based on the extension to the contract term authorized herein.

Section 3. Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the term of the Agreement will expire on September 30, 2025, and additional time is needed to distribute the remaining grant funds not yet disbursed to El Beth El.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
