## RESOLUTION 2024-561

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING J.D. THOMPSON FOR HIS HEROIC RESCUE OF LINEMAN RANDALL CHAMPION ON JULY 17, 1967; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 17, 1967, Jacksonville City Electric (now JEA) linemen J.D. Thompson and Randall Champion were working on utility poles on West 26<sup>th</sup> Street; and

WHEREAS, suddenly, Mr. Champion accidentally contacted one of the power lines and absorbed more than 2,400 volts of electricity, rendering him unconscious and suspended by his safety harness more than 20 feet off the ground; and

WHEREAS, without pause, J.D. Thompson descended the pole he was working on a few hundred feet away and charged towards Mr. Champion's pole, ascending rapidly in an effort to save his friend; and

WHEREAS, J.D. Thompson administered mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, desperately trying to breathe life back into Randall Champion. When he felt a pulse, he unhooked Mr. Champion's harness and helped lower him safely to the ground; and

WHEREAS, the heroic rescue was captured by local journalist Rocco Morabito in the Pulitzer Prize winning "The Kiss of Life" photograph, which appeared in newspapers around the world; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the incident, JEA implemented "horizontal hurtman training" for new linemen to prepare them to respond quickly when such an emergency occurs again; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby commends J.D.

Thompson for his heroic rescue of fellow lineman Randall Champion. Because of Mr. Thompson's brave action, Mr. Champion survived, was able to return to work as a lineman and was later promoted to troubleshooter as a result of the rescue.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
