ORDINANCE 2026-510

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING OPIOID AND SUBSTANCE USE
DISORDER SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS GRANTS;
APPROPRIATING \$5,279,951 FROM THE OPIOID
SETTLEMENT FUND CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE
OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND - SUBSIDIES AND
CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS ACCOUNT
TO FUND OPIOID AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER
SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS GRANTS ("OSUD GRANTS");
PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE OPIOID
ABATEMENT MANAGER WITHIN THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE
AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2026-2027 fiscal year,
within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$5,279,951 from
the designated Opioid Settlement Fund Contingency account

1 to the Opioid Settlement Fund - Subsidies and Contributions
2 to Private Organizations account to fund Opioid and
3 Substance Use Disorder Settlement Proceeds Grants ("OSUD
4 Grants") in fiscal year 2026-2027.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The OSUD Grant appropriation shall be
6 allocated to the Prevention (34%), Treatment (33%) and Recovery
7 Support (33%) categories as outlined and approved in Ordinance
8 2026-248-E, shall be used solely for the purpose of the listed Opioid
9 and Substance Use Disorder Settlement Proceeds Grant categories and
10 may not be transferred or reallocated for any other utilization within
11 the respective department. OSUD Grants are subject to the provisions
12 of Chapter 84, *Ordinance Code*. The appropriation made herein shall
13 be awarded as grants-in-aid to miscellaneous agencies and shall not
14 require additional legislation for distribution of funds. Pursuant
15 to Section 84.307, *Ordinance Code*, the Opioid and Substance Use
16 Disorder Grants Committee shall forward a complete list of the OSUD
17 Grants recipients and funding allocations to the Council Auditor's
18 Office, the Office of the Mayor, the City Council, and the Director
19 of the Finance Department.

20 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Manager of Opioid Abatement
21 within the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department shall oversee the
22 grants described herein.

23 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
25 without the Mayor's signature.
