AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$75,000.00 MAYORAL TRANSITION FUNDING WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND/ GENERAL SERVICE DISTRICT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO GATEWAY COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC. FOR A CONTRIBUTION FOR A HVAC UNIT AND INSTALLATION AT GATEWAY COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC.; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND GATEWAY COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC. FOR A CONTRIBUTION FOR A HVAC UNIT; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO DIRECT CONTRACT WITH GATEWAY COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC.; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2018-2019 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is from Mayoral Transitional Funding within the General Fund/General Service District to provide funding to Gateway Community Services, Inc. for a contribution for purchase of a HVAC unit and installation.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 above is to provide funding to Gateway Community Services, Inc. for a contribution for a HVAC Unit at Gateway Community Services, Inc. Gateway Community Services, Inc. is on the forefront in the fight against the opioid epidemic within Duval County. The HVAC unit will be used in the Administrative Building, which houses the training room and the kitchen, which prepares all meals for the in-house treatment residents.

Section 3. Agreement approved and execution authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Gateway Community Services, Inc., attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised Agmt, June 17, 2019 - NCSPHS", and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement provides for \$75,000 for a contribution for a HVAC Unit and installation.

Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),

Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to enter into an

agreement with Gateway Community Services, Inc. for a contribution for a HVAC Unit and installation. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

The Public Works Section 5. Oversight. Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Effective Date. This ordinance shall become Section 6. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
