Appropriation. For the 2025-2026 fiscal year, 16 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 17 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 18 19 listed in subsection (b): 20 (B.T. 26-009, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 21 by this reference) 22 (a) Appropriated from: See B.T. 26-009 \$292,610.25 23 24 (b) Appropriated to: See B.T. 26-009 25 \$292,610.25 Explanation of Appropriation: 26 (C) 27 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant funds in the amount of \$292,610.25 from the State of 2.8 29 Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") to develop the City of Jacksonville Adaptation Plan (the 30 "Project"). A local match from the City will not be 31

required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to receive and allocate FDEP's grant funding to the Project the purpose of which will be to prioritize capital improvement projects based upon their respective resilience benefits. FDEP has determined that the costs for the Project are eligible for 100 percent reimbursement up to \$292,610.25, which was the amount of funds left over after the completion of the Vulnerability Assessment previously authorized by Ordinance 2023-761-E. The State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Standard Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Agreement Number: 25PLN52) has been placed On File with the Legislative Services Division. The term of the grant commenced on July 1, 2024, and continues through June 30, 2027.

Section 3. Oversight. The Office of Resiliency of the Planning and Development Department shall oversee administration of the grant, the Project and the agreement described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
