8 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$36,000.00 FROM
9 THE SOCIAL JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY INVESTMENT
10 SPECIAL COMMITTEE CONTINGENCY TO PROVIDE
11 FUNDING TO CITY COUNCIL FOR THE "SAFER
12 TOGETHER" SERIES OF WORKSHOPS FOR FACILITATION
13 (\$23,500), TRAVEL AND HONORARIUM (\$10,000),
14 AND MISCELLANEOUS EXPENSES (\$2,500); APPROVING,
15 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL TO EXECUTE
16 AND DELIVER AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
17 JACKSONVILLE AND ALL THINGS DIVERSE, LLC, FOR
18 SERVICES RENDERED ON BEHALF OF THE "SAFER
19 TOGETHER" SERIES OF WORKSHOPS; INVOKING THE
20 EXCEPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G), *ORDINANCE*
21 *CODE*, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH ALL THINGS
22 DIVERSE, LLC, TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES FOR THE
23 "SAFER TOGETHER" SERIES OF WORKSHOPS; WAIVING
24 SECTION 110.112 (ADVANCE OF CITY FUNDS;
25 PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE CITY
26 TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY),
27 *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO ALLOW FOR A PARTIAL ADVANCE
28 PAYMENT BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT
29 BY THE COUNCIL SECRETARY; PROVIDING FOR
30 REVERTER OF FUNDS; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE
31 EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above is being appropriated from the Social Justice and Community Investment Special Committee Contingency to City Council to provide funding for the "Safer Together" Series of Workshops.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to City Council in the amount of \$36,000.00 for the "Safer Together" Series of Workshops for facilitation (\$23,500), travel and honorarium (\$10,000), and miscellaneous expenses (\$2,500), as more fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto.

Section 3. Approval and authorization to execute Service Contract. The City Council is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with All Things Diverse, LLC for compensation for services rendered to the "Safer Together" Series of Workshops. A copy of the agreement with scope of services is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),

1 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to directly procure
2 the use of the professional services of All Things Diverse, LLC, to
3 provide services as more particularly described in Section 2.
4 Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General
5 Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such
6 procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the
7 supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically
8 prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the
9 same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of
10 Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect.

11 **Section 5. Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Code.**

12 Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part
13 1 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), *Ordinance Code*,
14 is hereby waived to allow for a partial advance payment as
15 described in the Agreement.

16 **Section 6. Oversight.** The Council Secretary will oversee

17 the Agreement described in Section 3 above and to ensure compliance
18 with all other appropriate laws.

19 **Section 7. Reverter.** Any unused funds shall revert to the

20 account of origin.

21 **Section 8. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage**

22 **Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency
23 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the
24 emergency is that the "Safer Together" Series of Workshops have
25 commenced and the workshops need to be completed by June 30, 2021.

26 **Section 9. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become

27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
28 without the Mayor's signature.
