6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$534,628.00 FROM THE  
7 5TH STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO THE TAR  
8 KILN BRIDGE PROJECT TO PAY FOR DESIGN AND  
9 CONSTRUCTION OF GUARDRAIL UPGRADES AND OTHER  
10 MAINTENANCE ITEMS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-029;  
11 AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL  
12 IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-  
13 E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM  
14 THE 5TH STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO THE  
15 TAR KILN BRIDGE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
16 DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
22 listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

30 The funding above represents an appropriation of  
31 \$534,628.00 from the 5<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge Replacement project

1 to the Tar Kiln Bridge project to pay for design and  
2 construction of guardrail upgrades and other maintenance  
3 items.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
5 Section 1 is to allocate funds from the 5<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge Replacement  
6 project to the Tar Kiln Bridge project (the "Project"). The Project  
7 will entail upgrading the guardrails to current Florida Department  
8 of Transportation (FDOT) standards, raising the approach slabs to the  
9 original design profile, resolving standing water conditions  
10 following rain events, and replacement of damaged sidewalks in the  
11 vicinity of the bridge. This reallocation of funds is necessary for  
12 completion of the Project as the low bids received by the Public  
13 Works Department exceeded the available budget. The 5<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge  
14 Replacement project has been accepted into the FDOT Local Agency  
15 Program (LAP). The FDOT LAP will make other funding sources available  
16 for completion of that project resulting in the funds appropriated  
17 by this Ordinance being made available for reallocation to the Tar  
18 Kiln Bridge project.

19 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance  
20 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan  
21 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is  
22 hereby amended to this reallocation of funds from the 5<sup>th</sup> Street  
23 Bridge Replacement project to the Tar Kiln Bridge project as more  
24 fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as  
25 **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP Sheets,  
26 February 7, 2023 - Finance" and incorporated herein by this reference.  
27 The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP  
28 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to  
29 the best interests of the community because such deferral will  
30 unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

31 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of

1 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
2 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP  
3 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute  
4 an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the  
5 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E  
6 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

7 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
8 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
9 without the Mayor's signature.
