AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING 6 7 AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS), ORDINANCE CODE; 8 RENAMING A ROADWAY CURRENTLY IDENTIFIED AS 9 "LENOX SOUARE" TO "TIPHNE D. HOLLIS LANE" IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 9; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT OF 10 11 SECTION 745.105 (PUBLIC STREET NAME CHANGES), 12 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 745 PART 13 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS), 14 ORDINANCE CODE, THAT THE PERSON HAVE ACHIEVED 15 PROMINENCE AS А RESULT OF HIS OR HER SIGNIFICANT, POSITIVE CONTRIBUTION TO THE UNITED 16 17 STATES OF AMERICA, FLORIDA AND/OR THE LOCAL 18 COMMUNITY; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD A COPY 19 OF THIS ORDINANCE, ONCE ENACTED, TO THE PUBLIC 20 DEPARTMENT, DEVELOPMENT 21 WORKS SERVICES AND 22 TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISIONS, FOR PROCESSING 23 AND COORDINATION WITH 911 EMERGENCY, THE 24 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, THE 25 U.S. POSTAL SERVICE, AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES 26 AND ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the Addressing Section of the Public Works Department, Development Services Division, received an application to re-name a roadway currently identified as "Lenox Square" to "Tiphne D. Hollis Lane" and copies of the application and receipt of payment 1 are attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2, respectively, and 2 incorporated herein by this reference; and

3 WHEREAS, Tiphne Dar'Shay Hollis tragically passed away on
4 March 20, 2010, at the young age of 16 years old; and

5 WHEREAS, Shanda Ward, the applicant and mother of Tiphne D. 6 Hollis, is determined to keep Tiphne's memory alive by establishing 7 a street name in Tiphne's honor; and

8 WHEREAS, the family and friends of Tiphne D. Hollis have also 9 opened a Christian learning academy and established the Tiphne 10 Dar'Shay Hollis Foundation, Inc., dedicated to Ms. Hollis' short but 11 vibrant legacy; and

WHEREAS, upon this legislation becoming effective, the City will install a new street sign at the affected roadway to reflect Tiphne D. Hollis Lane" as the designated street name; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department, Development Services Division, presented a recommendation to the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee to approve the renaming of "Lenox Square" to "Tiphne D. Hollis Lane" and a copy of said presentation is attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference; and

20 WHEREAS, on March 5, 2025, the 911 Emergency Addressing 21 Advisory Committee considered this matter during a public meeting and 22 voted to accept the staff recommendation to rename "Lenox Square" to 23 "Tiphne D. Hollis Lane" and a summary of the minutes of said meeting 24 is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by this 25 reference; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the Community Planning Division, Historic Preservation Section, of the Planning and Development Department issued a Memorandum indicating the Planning and Development Department staff had no objection to the proposed renaming of "Lenox Square" to "Tiphne D. Hollis Lane" and a copy of said Memorandum is attached hereto as **Exhibit 5** and incorporated herein

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by this reference; and

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WHEREAS, on March 26, 2025, the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission ("JHPC") held a public meeting where it considered this matter and voted to rename "Lenox Square" to "Tiphne D. Hollis Lane" and a copy of the relevant portion of the transcript of said meeting is attached hereto as **Exhibit 6** and incorporated herein by this reference; and

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 745.105(i)(6), Ordinance Code, 9 the Addressing Section mailed a notification letter on March 11, 10 2025, to one affected property owner requesting the property owner 11 to indicate their consent or objection to the proposed street re-12 naming and a copy of the notification letter is attached as **Exhibit** 13 7 and incorporated herein by this reference; and

14 WHEREAS, on April 12, 2025, the affected property owner 15 indicated their written consent of the proposed street re-naming and 16 a copy of the written consent is attached as **Exhibit 8** and 17 incorporated herein by this reference; and

18 WHEREAS, based upon the application, recommendations, and 19 comments from Public Works Department staff, the Emergency Addressing 20 Advisory Committee, Planning and Development Department staff, and 21 the JHPC, the City Council desires to rename "Lenox Square" to "Tiphne 22 D. Hollis Lane"; now therefore

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**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Lenox Square Renamed as "Tiphne D. Hollis Lane". The roadway currently identified as "Lenox Square" is hereby renamed to "Tiphne D. Hollis Lane" by which name such street and physical location shall be hereafter known and designated. A copy of the map of Tiphne D. Hollis Lane is attached hereto as **Exhibit 9** and incorporated herein by this reference.

30 Section 2. Waiver of Certain Requirements of Section
 31 745.105, Ordinance Code. The requirement of subsection

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1 745.105(i)(1), Ordinance Code, that the person have achieved 2 prominence as a result of his or her significant, positive 3 contribution to the United States of America, Florida and/or the 4 local community is hereby waived as Ms. Hollis' life was taken too 5 soon.

6 Section 3. Direction to Chief of the Legislative Services 7 Division. The Chief of the Legislative Services Division is hereby 8 directed to send a copy of this Ordinance, once enacted, to the Public 9 Works Department, Development Services and Traffic Engineering 10 Divisions, for processing, implementation, and coordination with 911 11 Emergency, the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department, the U.S. 12 Postal Service, and other affected agencies and organizations.

13 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 15 without the Mayor's signature.
