WHEREAS, law enforcement officers put themselves in harm's way every day in an effort to maintain public safety. Jacksonville Sheriff's Officers work together as a tightly-knit team, supporting each other and cooperating to ensure the security of their unit; and

WHEREAS, when JSO Officer Malik Daricaud was assisting fellow officers with a follow-up investigation for a traffic incident in March 2023, he was shot and seriously injured by a suspect. Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby commends JSO Sergeant Ahmetovic, Officer Redmond and Officer Cotton for their
