ORDINANCE 2023-513

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 FUNDS (THE "ARP ACT") (ORIGINALLY APPROPRIATED BY ORDINANCE 2022-513-E) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$63,625,214.50 FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO BE DISBURSED AS FOLLOWS: (1) \$15,000,000 TO SHANDS JACKSONVILLE MEDICAL CENTER, INC. FOR INDIGENT HEALTH CARE, \$10,000,000 FOR HEALTH CARE CLAIMS PAID, (3) TASK \$13,625,214.50 TO THE MAYOR'S CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO SUPPORT VARIOUS INITIATIVES AND PRIORITIES FOCUSED INFRASTRUCTURE, HEALTH, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, SAFETY, CONSTITUENCY AND PUBLIC COMMUNITY OUTREACH, MILITARY AND VETERANS, AND ARTS, CULTURE AND ENTERTAINMENT IDENTIFIED BY THE MAYOR'S TRANSITION COMMITTEES AND FOCUS GROUPS, AND (4) \$25,000,000 TO UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA (UF) HEALTH FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO CITY-OWNED FACILITIES, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-107; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS FROM YEAR TO YEAR UNTIL SUCH FUNDS ARE EXPENDED OR LAPSE, AND PROVIDING THAT ANY ARP ACT FUNDING APPROPRIATED HEREIN THAT IS NOT OBLIGATED BY DECEMBER 31, 2024 AND EXPENDED PURSUANT TO THIS ORDINANCE BY DECEMBER 31, 2026, SHALL REVERT ACCOUNT(S) OF ORIGIN FOR REAPPROPRIATION FOR

AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURES UNDER THE TERMS OF THE ARP ACT OR FOR RETURN TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY, AS APPLICABLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding appropriated above represents a transfer of \$63,625,214.50 in American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (the "ARP Act") funds originally appropriated by Ordinance 2022-513-E from the American Rescue Plan Local Fiscal Recovery Fund Contingency account to provide: (1) \$40,000,000 to Shands Jacksonville Medical Center, Inc., (2) \$10,000,000 to the Health Care Claims Paid - Group Health account, and (3) \$13,625,214.50 to the Mayor's Task Force Contingency account.

Section 2. Carryover. The funds appropriated by this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover as appropriated from year to year until such funds are expended or lapse. In accordance with the ARP Act, funds appropriated in this Ordinance must be obligated by December 31, 2024 and expended on or before December 31,

2026. Failure to do so will cause said funds to revert to the account(s) of origin for reappropriation for authorized expenditures under the terms of the ARP Act, subject to Council approval, or to return to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, as applicable.

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to allocate ARP Act local fiscal recovery funds remaining in the American Rescue Plan Local Fiscal Recovery Fund Contingency account as follows: (1) \$15,000,000 to Shands Jacksonville Medical Center, Inc. for indigent health care, (2) \$10,000,000 to Health Care Claims Paid, (3) \$13,625,214.50 to the Mayor's Task Force Contingency account to support various priorities and initiatives focused on infrastructure, health, economic development, public safety, constituency and community outreach, military and veterans, and arts, culture and entertainment identified by the Mayor's Transition Committees and focus groups, and (4) \$25,000,000 to UF Health for capital improvements to City-owned facilities.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
