The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO) is seeking authorization to submit legislation necessary to amend Chapter 37 of the Municipal Code to broaden the scope of cooperative agreements that the Sheriff can execute. The current language limits these agreements to federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies. Since this language was originally added to the Ordinance Code, there have been multiple instances where executing an agreement with a non-law enforcement entity (e.g. non-profits and private businesses) would be beneficial to the Sheriff's Office and the community. The execution of these agreements would adhere to all the other requirements set forth in Chapter 37.101(m).
