## ORDINANCE 2022-490-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, THE SHERIFF OF DUVAL COUNTY, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO ENTER INTO A TRAFFIC CONTROL AGREEMENT WITH PABLO CREEK RESERVE HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC., PURSUANT TO SECTION 316.006, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING AUTHORIZATION FOR JSO TO ENFORCE PABLO CREEK RESERVE NEIGHBORHOOD'S 25 MPH SPEED LIMIT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowners' Association, Inc. has requested the Jacksonville Sheriff's office to perform traffic monitoring on private roads within the Pablo Creek Reserve community located near San Pablo Road; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowner' Association, Inc., on May 4, 2022, voted to allow the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to enter Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowners' Association, Inc. property to perform such traffic controls and approved entering into a contract documenting same; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the minutes of the May 4, 2022 Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowners' Association, Inc. meeting approving same are attached hereto as Exhibit 1; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved and the Mayor, or his designee, the Sheriff of Duval County, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute a Traffic

Inc., in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, pursuant to Section 316.006, Florida Statutes, for municipal traffic control jurisdiction by the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office over the limited access roads located within the boundaries of the Pablo Creek Reserve community.

Section 2. Providing Authorization for JSO to Enforce Pablo

Control Agreement with Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowners' Association,

Creek Reserve Neighborhood Speed Limit of 25 MPH. Pursuant to Section 804.402, Ordinance Code, the City may vary and post speed limits throughout the City to promote the efficient flow of traffic and the safety of motorists and pedestrians upon public streets and highways. The internal roads of the Pablo Creek Reserve community are private, and the speed limit has been posted at a maximum of 25 miles per hour. The City Council hereby authorizes the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to enforce the posted speed limit of 25 miles per hour on the private roads within the Pablo Creek Reserve community.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
