5 **ORDINANCE 2022-490-E**

6 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE  
7 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, THE SHERIFF OF DUVAL  
8 COUNTY, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO ENTER  
9 INTO A TRAFFIC CONTROL AGREEMENT WITH PABLO  
10 CREEK RESERVE HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.,  
11 PURSUANT TO SECTION 316.006, *FLORIDA STATUTES*;  
12 PROVIDING AUTHORIZATION FOR JSO TO ENFORCE PABLO  
13 CREEK RESERVE NEIGHBORHOOD'S 25 MPH SPEED LIMIT;  
14 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **WHEREAS**, Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowners' Association, Inc. has  
17 requested the Jacksonville Sheriff's office to perform traffic  
18 monitoring on private roads within the Pablo Creek Reserve community  
19 located near San Pablo Road; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of Pablo Creek Reserve  
21 Homeowner' Association, Inc., on May 4, 2022, voted to allow the  
22 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to enter Pablo Creek Reserve  
23 Homeowners' Association, Inc. property to perform such traffic  
24 controls and approved entering into a contract documenting same; and

25 **WHEREAS**, a copy of the minutes of the May 4, 2022 Pablo Creek  
26 Reserve Homeowners' Association, Inc. meeting approving same are  
27 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**; now therefore

28 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

29 **Section 1. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby  
30 approved and the Mayor, or his designee, the Sheriff of Duval County,  
31 and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute a Traffic

1 Control Agreement with Pablo Creek Reserve Homeowners' Association,  
2 Inc., in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, pursuant  
3 to Section 316.006, *Florida Statutes*, for municipal traffic control  
4 jurisdiction by the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office over the limited  
5 access roads located within the boundaries of the Pablo Creek Reserve  
6 community.

7 **Section 2. Providing Authorization for JSO to Enforce Pablo**  
8 **Creek Reserve Neighborhood Speed Limit of 25 MPH.** Pursuant to Section  
9 804.402, *Ordinance Code*, the City may vary and post speed limits  
10 throughout the City to promote the efficient flow of traffic and the  
11 safety of motorists and pedestrians upon public streets and highways.  
12 The internal roads of the Pablo Creek Reserve community are private,  
13 and the speed limit has been posted at a maximum of 25 miles per  
14 hour. The City Council hereby authorizes the Jacksonville Sheriff's  
15 Office to enforce the posted speed limit of 25 miles per hour on the  
16 private roads within the Pablo Creek Reserve community.

17 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
18 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
19 without the Mayor's signature.
