## ORDINANCE 2025-362-E

AN ORDINANCE MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND APPROPRIATING \$12,000,000 FROM DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND LOAN PROCEEDS TO THE JACKSONVILLE ZOO IMPROVEMENTS - DM OTHER CONSTRUCTION COSTS FOR ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDS IMPROVEMENTS AT THE CITY-OWNED FACILITY LOCATED AT 370 ZOO PARKWAY, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32218; 2025-2029 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL AMENDING THE IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2024-505-E TO REFLECT THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS AUTHORIZED HEREIN TO THE PROJECT ENTITLED "JACKSONVILLE ZOO IMPROVEMENTS" (THE "PROJECT"); AMENDING ORDINANCE 2024-504-E, THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 BUDGET, TO REPLACE THE SECOND REVISED SCHEDULE B4, THE FY 24-25 DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND DETAIL, AND THE REVISED SCHEDULE B4-B, THE FY 24-25 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FUNDED VIA BORROWING, TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING AND/OR ISSUANCE OF FIXED-RATE DEBT FOR THE PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE A SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE CAPITAL MAINTENANCE AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS COST DISBURSEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE JACKSONVILLE ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY, INC. (CITY CONTRACT NO. 7182-32) AS PROVIDED HEREIN;

PROVIDING A CONDITION PRECEDENT TO ANY FUTURE REQUESTS FOR FUNDING OR CITY DISBURSEMENT OF THE FINAL \$4,000,000 PAYMENT PLANNED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 FOR THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City and The Jacksonville Zoological Society, Inc. (the "Zoological Society") previously entered into that certain Capital Maintenance and Capital Improvements Cost Disbursement Agreement dated May 17, 2019, whereby the City agreed to fund capital improvements to the City-owned land and facilities occupied and managed by the Zoological Society over a five-year period; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget, the City committed to a new five-year capital improvements contribution to the Zoological Society in an amount of \$4,000,000 per year (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, due to increased costs related to construction, the Zoological Society has requested the City revise the schedule of payments to be made toward capital improvements at the Zoo so the certain projects may be completed before further price increases can occur; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to move the payments originally scheduled for fiscal years 2026-2027, 2027-2028, and 2028-2029 for capital improvements at the Zoo to fiscal year 2024-2025 as authorized herein; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Findings. It is hereby ascertained, determined, found, and declared as follows:

- (a) The recitals set forth herein are true and correct.
- (b) The Project will promote and further the public and

municipal purposes of the City.

- The provision of the City's assistance as identified in the agreement between the City and The Jacksonville Zoological Society, Inc. is necessary and appropriate to make the Project feasible; and the City's assistance is reasonable and not excessive, taking into account the extent of the public benefits expected to be derived from the Project, and taking into account all other forms of assistance available.
- The Zoological Society and its contractors, are qualified to carry out and complete the construction and equipping of the Project.
- The authorizations provided by this Ordinance are for public uses and purposes for which the City may use its powers as a county, municipality and as a political subdivision of the State of Florida and may expend public funds, and the necessity in the public interest for the provisions herein enacted is hereby declared as a matter of legislative determination.
- Section 2. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

"Jacksonville Zoo Improvements" to The Jacksonville Zoological Society, Inc. for capital improvements to the City-owned facilities located at 370 Zoo Parkway, Jacksonville, Florida 32218.

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2 is to assist the Zoological Society in completing planned capital improvements to the City-owned facilities before further price increases can occur.

Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect the reallocation of funds for the project entitled "Jacksonville Zoo Improvements" (the "Project") originally scheduled to be disbursed in fiscal years 2026-2027, 2027-2028, and 2028-2029 to fiscal year 2024-2025 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delay of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the CIP approved by Ordinance 2024-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Amending Ordinance 2024-504-E, the FY 2024-2025 Budget, to Replace Second Revised Schedule B4 and Revised Schedule B4-b to Reflect Allocation of Funding for the Project. Ordinance

2024-504-E, the FY 2024-2025 Budget, is hereby amended to replace Second Revised Schedule B4, entitled "FY 24-25 Debt Management Fund Detail", and Revised Schedule B4-b, entitled "FY 24-25 Capital Improvement Projects Funded via Borrowing", to reflect the allocation of \$12,000,000 for the Project. The Third Revised Schedule B4 and Second Revised Schedule B4-b are attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and **Exhibit 4**, respectively.

Section 6. Authorizing Execution of a Sixth Amendment to City Contract No. 7182-32. The Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute a Sixth Amendment to Capital Maintenance and Capital Improvements Cost Disbursement Agreement Between the City of Jacksonville and The Jacksonville Zoological Society, Inc. (City Contract No. 7182-32) to reflect the appropriation of funds as authorized herein in substantially the form attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 5, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 5, Rev 6th Amd, June 17, 2025 - Finance".

Requests for Funding or Disbursement of Payment for the Project. The Zoological Society shall provide evidence to the City that it has met its responsibility under the Capital Maintenance and Capital Improvements Cost Disbursement Agreement Between the City of Jacksonville and The Jacksonville Zoological Society, Inc., as amended hereby, to match the \$12,000,000 in City funding described herein prior to making any requests for additional funding for the Project or the City's disbursement of the final \$4,000,000 payment for the Project planned for fiscal year 2025-2026.

Section 8. Oversight Department. The Public Works Department shall have oversight of the agreement and project described herein.

Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

without the Mayor's signature.
