4 **ORDINANCE 2026-105-E**

5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2026-2030 FIVE-YEAR
6 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE
7 2025-505-E TO REVISE THE TITLE AND SCOPE OF THE
8 PROJECT ENTITLED "JSO PRETRIAL DETENTION CENTER
9 - WATER REPLACEMENT"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
10 DATE.

12 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

13 **Section 1. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
14 2025-505-E, adopting the 2026-2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
15 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
16 hereby amended to revise the title of the project currently entitled
17 "JSO pretrial detention center - water replacement system" to
18 "Montgomery Correction Center - water replacement system" (Project
19 Number 011025) (the "Project") and to revise the scope of the Project
20 to remove references to the pretrial detention center and correct the
21 Project location address as more fully described in the Project
22 Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein
23 by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this
24 amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will
25 be detrimental to the best interests of the community because this
26 clarification is applicable to current year appropriations and is
27 necessary to complete the intended work at the Montgomery Correction
28 Center.

29 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
30 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
31 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP

1 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
2 an amendment to Ordinance 2025-505-E. In all other respects, the
3 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2025-505-E
4 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

5 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
6 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
7 without the Mayor's signature.
