Type of Action: Honorary Street designation, *Ordinance Code* waivers, and directive to Legislative Services

Bill Summary: This bill designates the portion 16th Street East extending from Main Street to Hubbard Street in Council District 7 to have an Honorary Street Designation for “Cedric Burrell”, with 2 honorary roadside markers on 16th Street East. Subsection 745.105(i)(2), and Subsection 745.105(i)(3) *Ordinance Code* are waived. There was no objection in response to the Notice to the 10 affected property owners. The Legislative Services Division is directed to forward a copy of this Ordinance, once enacted, to the Public Works Department, Addressing Unit.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to honorarily designate a portion of 16th Street East proximal to Island Tropics restaurant after Cedric Burrell. Mr. Burrell and his wife, Sydney Burrell, owned and operated Island Tropics restaurant located at 2527 North Main Street for more than 20 years. Mr. Burrell also dedicated much of his time and resources into revitalizing the neighborhood. Mr. Burrell passed away in June of 2024. There are waivers in the bill related to the requirement that the honoree be deceased for more than 5 years, and the requirement that the honoree reside in the community within five miles of the designated street for at least ten years.
