BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

7 funding above represents an appropriation The of \$986,000.00, including (1) \$493,000.00 from the project 8 9 titled Nungezer Road ("Nungezer Project") to the project 10 titled San Mateo Elementary School Sidewalk ("San Mateo Project") to provide funding to complete the San Mateo 11 Project which includes the construction of approximately 12 3,500 feet of sidewalk along Eastport Road from Main Street 13 to Aaron Road, crossing CSX railroad tracks, and (2) 14 \$493,000.00 from the Authorized Capital Projects Fund to 15 the Local Option and Constitutional Gas Taxes Fund with 16 17 respect to the Cedar Point/Sawpit Road (New Berlin To Shark) Project ("Cedar Point Project" and together with 18 the San Mateo Project, the "Projects"), and also updating 19 20 prior appropriations to reflect actuals.

21 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 22 Section 1 is to allocate funds from the Nungezer Project to the San 23 Mateo Project and transfer \$493,000.00 between funds with respect to 24 the Cedar Point Project. The San Mateo Project provides approximately 25 3,500 feet of sidewalk along Eastport Road from Main Street to Aaron 26 Road, crossing CSX railroad tracks, including a crosswalk improvement 27 to aid students walking north of Eastport Road towards San Mateo 28 Elementary. The Cedar Point Project provides widening, milling and 29 resurfacing Sawpit Road from Cedar Point to Shark Road. This 30 reallocation of funds and appropriation is necessary to allow for the 31 completion of the Projects. In addition, the appropriation updates

1 prior appropriations to reflect actuals.

2 Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 3 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is 4 5 hereby amended to modify the scope of the San Mateo Project and appropriate funds to the Projects as more fully described in the 6 7 Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that 8 9 the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget 10 and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion 11 12 of the Projects.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

20 Section 4. Oversight. The Engineering and Construction 21 Management Division of the Department of Public Works shall have 22 oversight in the projects described herein.

23 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 25 without the Mayor's signature.
