5 AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$802,300.54 IN FEDERAL  
6 GRANT FUNDS FROM PERMANENT AND PROBATIONARY  
7 SALARIES AND ASSOCIATED FRINGE BENEFITS TO  
8 CONTRACTUAL SERVICES TO EXPAND THE CITY'S  
9 EXISTING CONTRACT WITH FAMILY FOUNDATIONS OF  
10 NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC. TO PROVIDE INTERVENTION  
11 AND PREVENTION SERVICES TO HIGH RISK  
12 PARTICIPANTS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-048;  
13 AUTHORIZING POSITIONS, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 24-  
14 075; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION  
15 126.107(E) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL  
16 REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE),  
17 *ORDINANCE CODE*; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE  
18 MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
19 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF  
20 THE CITY AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF  
21 JACKSONVILLE AND FAMILY FOUNDATIONS OF NORTHEAST  
22 FLORIDA, INC.; PROVIDING OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS  
23 AND CONTRACTS COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE  
24 AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR  
25 CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025;  
26 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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28 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

29 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,  
30 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
31 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)

8 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

9 The funding above represents a transfer in the amount of  
10 \$802,300.54 in federal grant funds from permanent and  
11 probationary salaries and associated fringe benefits to  
12 contractual services to expand the City's existing contract  
13 with Family Foundations of Northeast Florida, Inc. to  
14 provide intervention and prevention services to high risk  
15 participants. No local match is required.

16 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
17 Section 1 is to transfer funds within the Mayor's Violence Reduction  
18 Center Accounts for contractual services and pension contribution.  
19 This funding will also support one (1) position within the Grants and  
20 Contracts Compliance Division.

21 **Section 3. Approval of Positions.** There is hereby approved  
22 the position more fully described in R.C. 24-075, attached hereto as  
23 **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

24 **Section 4. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(e),**  
25 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the  
26 professional services of Family Foundations of Northeast Florida,  
27 Inc. pursuant to Section 126.107(e) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General  
28 Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*. Such  
29 procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the  
30 supplies or services are prevention services related to mental health.  
31 The Family Foundations of Northeast Florida, Inc. operates a not-for-

1 profit corporation and has demonstrated the ability to provide high-  
2 quality, cost-efficient services in a timely manner.

3       **Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute.** There is  
4 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation  
5 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of  
6 the City an agreement with Family Foundations of Northeast Florida,  
7 Inc., in substantially the same form as attached as **Exhibit 3** and  
8 incorporated herein by reference.

9       **Section 6. Carryover.** The funds appropriated by this  
10 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-  
11 2025.

12       **Section 7. Oversight.** The Grants and Contract Compliance  
13 Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall oversee  
14 the Grant Agreement described herein.

15       **Section 8. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
17 without the Mayor's signature.
