Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to establish the fiscal year 2025-2026 operating budget for the Domestic Battery Surcharge Trust Fund. The funds will be used to provide additional training to law enforcement personnel in combating domestic violence.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
