AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$70,296 FROM GENERAL FUND OPERATING SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL OPERATING SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE CITY GRANT FUNDING TO UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA ("UNF") FOR THE UNF MILITARY AND VETERANS PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; WAIVING SECTION 118.503 (LOSS OF ELIGIBILITY FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS CHAPTER), PART 5 (LIABILITY AND LOSS OF ENTITLEMENT OR ELIGIBILITY FOR CITY GRANTS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW UNF TO RECEIVE CITY GRANT FUNDS WHILE ON THE CITY'S CHAPTER 118 NON-COMPLIANCE LIST; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND UNF FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$70,296 from a General Fund Operating Special Council Contingency account to the General Fund Operating Subsidies and Contributions to Private Org account, to provide a grant to University of North Florida ("UNF") for the UNF Military and Veterans Program (the "Program") as described herein.

Section 2. The purpose of the appropriation in Purpose. Section 1 is to provide grant funds from the City of Jacksonville to the University of North Florida for the UNF Military and Veterans Program as described in **Exhibit 2**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program is operated out of the UNF Military and Veterans Resource Center (the "MVRC") which serves over 2,000 military-connected students and provides access to technology and equipment to assist students in their educational pursuits as well as a location for work study groups, completion of class projects, student collaborations, and development of presentations. Two specific programs offered at the UNF MVRC that will be supported by the City grant dollars include the SBDC Military Spouse Career Readiness Seminar and the Veteran/Military Student Entrepreneurship Bootcamp and Pitch Competition. The Spouse Career Readiness Seminar

provides targeted training, mentorship and resources to help military spouses explore entrepreneurship opportunities as a viable career path while the Bootcamp and Pitch Competition were designed to provide opportunities for military and veteran students attending UNF to explore innovation, creativity and entrepreneurship and to develop the skillset necessary to achieve their entrepreneurship goals.

The City funds will be used to purchase two interactive electronic whiteboards for installation in the main area and a private study room at the MVRC and to purchase equipment and make improvements to the MVRC kitchen where military-connected students have access to free refreshments throughout the day. A portion of the City funds will also be used to purchase a golf cart to transport disabled and mobility-challenged veterans and military-connected students around the MVRC campus. Finally, a portion of the funds will be used for office expenses, space rentals, and marketing materials as well as a portion of the salaries and benefits for a Coordinator and a Facilitator to support the SBRC Military Spouse Career Readiness Seminar and a Cohort Facilitator and Mentors for the Entrepreneurship Bootcamp and Pitch Competition.

Section 3. Waiver of Section 118.503, Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.503 (Loss of eligibility for failure to comply with this Chapter), Part 5 (Liability and Loss of Entitlement or Eligibility for City Grants), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow the University of North Florida to receive a City grant as the University of North Florida is currently on the Chapter 118 Non-Compliance List for failure to timely submit an annual audit as required pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 118, Ordinance Code. This waiver is justified because UNF's audit is conducted by the State Auditor General and is not expected to be received until March 2025, thus precluding UNF from timely submitting its audit in compliance with the Code.
