Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Donald Oulton to the Jacksonville – Duval County Council on Elder Affairs, replacing Dr. Geraldine Mackoul Ferris, for a first full term ending June 30, 2025.

Background Information: The Jacksonville-Duval County Council on Elder Affairs is established pursuant to Chapter 82, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to serve as an advocate for the older persons in the city, to the governmental agencies responsible for the various plans and programs designed to help older persons; assist in the implementation of plans and programs selected by regional organizations, as they relate to the city and its citizens; designate priorities among programs developed in the city by public, nonprofit and private providers concerning older persons.

Section 82.101, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Council on Elder Affairs shall be composed of 19 members, of which five at large members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council.

Mr. Oulton was raised in Green Cove Springs and moved to Jacksonville in 1974. He retired from the automotive industry in 2013 after a long career. Mr. Oulton established the neighborhood association in his neighborhood in 1998 and is an active member of the Greater Arlington/Beaches CPAC. He resides in Duval County in council district 4.
