Type of Action: Closure/abandonment of Right-of-Way

Bill Summary: This bill closes and abandons an opened and improved portion of Jake Road Right-of-Way and an unopened and unimproved portion of an unnamed drainage Right-of-Way in council district 2.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to close and abandon portions of rights-of-way to allow for the installation of a security fence and consolidation of the properties into one large property for a retirement homestead. There were no objections to the Applicant's requests by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the rights-of-way.

Policy Impact Area: Closure/abandonment of Right-of-Way

Fiscal Impact: Applicant has paid two closure application fees of \$2,091.00 (for a total of \$4,182.00)
