ORDINANCE 2022-516-E

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE CREATION OF ADMINISTRATOR POSITION TO SUPPORT THE WORK OF THE DUVAL COUNTY TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL ("TDC") AND ITS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR; \$13,823.00 FROM APPROPRIATING TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL FUND BALANCE TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR SUCH POSITION; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; APPROVING THE POSITION, INITIATED BY R.C. 22-164; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the TDC has identified a need to create and hire the job position of administrator to support the work of the TDC and its executive director as authorized under Section 70.103(d), Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on June 30, 2022, the TDC approved the creation of this position; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the account listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation.

This ordinance appropriates \$13,823 from Tourist Development Council fund balance to the TDC Administration activity to provide funding for the salaries, benefits, and office expenses of the administrator position through September 30, 2022.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the creation of the job position of administrator in order to provide administrative and office support to the TDC and its executive director.

Section 3. Approval of Position. There is hereby approved the position more fully described in R.C. 22-164, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.
