(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is comprised of an appropriation of a \$1,750,000.00 grant from the U.S. Department of Justice/Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (the "Grant"), and an appropriation of \$250,000 from the Reserve for Federal Programs Contingency account and \$3,226,737 from General Fund fund balance to cover the required local match for the first year of the Grant and additional operating expenses to outfit and train the forty (40) new police officers hired under the Grant.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund forty (40) full-time police officer positions within the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office for the Grant period beginning October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2028 (the "Grant Term"). A copy of the COPS Hiring Program Grant Award letter (Award Number 15JCOPS-23-GG-04521-UHPX) is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Grant Award Letter"). The Grant requires a local match from the City in the total amount of \$2,565,400.00 during the Grant Term, of which \$771,800.00 of the \$3,476,737.00 in City funds are being appropriated pursuant to this Ordinance to cover the City's first year match and \$2,704,937.00 of the appropriation, which does not qualify as part of the City's match, is for additional operating expenses to outfit and train the forty
