Bill Summary: The bill waives the finding of non-compliance by FBOT Pipeline, Inc. with the Permit Requirement during the FY23 City Grant Agreement term. It requests one-cycle emergency passage.

Background Information: The City and FBOT entered into a contract in October 2022, with the City providing a grant in the amount of \$165,000 for the Green District Phase I Affordable Housing Project in Durkeville. Section II.B.2 of the FY23 City Grant Agreement required that the nonprofit entity obtain and maintain all permits required by the State of Florida, and the nonprofit entity inadvertently failed to comply with this requirement. As a result of the non-compliance, the company is ineligible to receive reimbursement payments. The nonprofit is otherwise in compliance with the Citty Grant Agreement terms and Chapter 118, Parts 1-5 of the Ordinance Code.

Policy Impact Area: Eligibility for City grant funding

Fiscal Impact: Restores the ability of the company to receive City grant funding.
