4 **RESOLUTION 2024-960**

5 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT
6 OF DR. TAMMY HODO, A DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT, AS
7 A MEMBER OF THE JACKSONVILLE JOURNEY FORWARD
8 BOARD WITH EXPERIENCE IN COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT,
9 PURSUANT TO SECTION 85.105, *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR
10 AN INITIAL FOUR-YEAR TERM EXPIRING SEPTEMBER 30,
11 2028; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2024-635-E established the Jacksonville
14 Journey Forward as a public body within the executive branch of the
15 City to assess and make recommendations regarding community-based
16 programs, services, activities, and contracts related to factors
17 contributing to crime prevention, intervention, and rehabilitation
18 as well as neighborhood safety and stability, and the prevention of
19 juvenile and adult recidivism; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Journey Forward also serves as a
21 convenor to organize and engage City agencies, offices, departments,
22 independent agencies, and community leaders and stakeholders to
23 establish a community-based, Citywide plan and alignment of resources
24 to reduce factors contributing to crime and to improve public safety;
25 and

26 **WHEREAS**, Section 85.105(a), *Ordinance Code*, outlines the
27 composition of the Jacksonville Journey Forward Board ("JF Board")
28 which shall consist of eleven voting members, four of whom are
29 appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council, three of whom shall
30 be appointed by the Council President and confirmed by Council with
31 the following persons making one appointment for confirmation by

1 Council, to wit: the Sheriff of Duval County, the State Attorney of
2 the Fourth Judicial Circuit, the Superintendent of Duval County Public
3 Schools, and the Chief Judge for the Fourth Judicial Circuit; and

4 **WHEREAS**, to the extent feasible and preferred, but not required,
5 members appointed to serve on the JF Board shall include individuals
6 with experience in one or more of the following areas, recognizing
7 these qualifications would best serve the mission and objectives of
8 the Jacksonville Journey Forward: public health, education, workforce
9 development, contracts and compliance, afterschool/camp operations,
10 juvenile diversion programs, violence prevention or intervention, ex-
11 offender re-entry programs, law enforcement and community engagement;
12 now therefore

13 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1. Appointment Confirmation.** The Council hereby
15 confirms the Mayor's appointment of Dr. Tammy Hodo, a Duval County
16 resident, as a member of the Jacksonville Journey Forward Board with
17 experience in community engagement, in accordance with Section
18 85.105, *Ordinance Code*, for an initial four-year term expiring on
19 September 30, 2028.

20 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
22 without the Mayor's signature.
