6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$281,321.00,
7 INCLUDING \$267,924.76 IN GRANT FUNDING AWARDED
8 BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND
9 THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY THROUGH
10 THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 FIRE PREVENTION & SAFETY
11 GRANT PROGRAM AND A \$13,396.24 CITY MATCH, TO
12 PURCHASE A FIRE SAFETY HOUSE INTERACTIVE
13 LEARNING CENTER TRAILER AND A FIRE DOG PUBLIC
14 EDUCATION COSTUME, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-088;
15 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND
16 RESCUE DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
17 DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
22 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
23 listed in subsection (b):

31 The funding above represents an appropriation of

1 \$281,321.00, including \$267,924.76 in grant funding
2 awarded by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and
3 the Federal Emergency Management Agency through the Fiscal
4 Year 2021 Fire Prevention & Safety Grant Program, and a
5 \$13,396.24 City match. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
6 Department ("JFRD") will use the funds to purchase a Fire
7 Safety House Interactive Learning Center Trailer and a Fire
8 Dog Public Education Costume. The grant period of
9 performance commences April 11, 2023, and ends April 10,
10 2024.

11 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
12 Section 1 is to provide funding for the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
13 Department to purchase a Fire Safety House Interactive Learning Center
14 Trailer with an interactive kitchen emergency training room feature
15 and a Fire Dog Public Education Costume. These items will be used
16 to enhance JFRD's public safety education program. A copy of the
17 Fiscal Year 2021 Fire Prevention & Safety Grant Program Award Letter
18 (Grant Number: EMW-2021-FP-00043), providing the terms and conditions
19 relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds, has been
20 placed **On File** with the Legislative Services Division.

21 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
22 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee
23 administration of the grant described herein.

24 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
25 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
26 without the Mayor's signature.
