28 order to utilize funds from the United Way of Northeast Florida,

30 with guidelines set forth in the United Way of Northeast Florida
31 Funding Agreement between the United Way of Northeast Florida and

1 the City of Jacksonville, for and on behalf of Jacksonville's
2 Department of Military Affairs and Veterans, a copy of which as
3 been attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
