5 **ORDINANCE 2025-466-E**

6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$15,000 FROM THE
7 SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE
8 SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG
9 ACCOUNT WITHIN THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE ("KHA")
10 FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO DELTA SIGMA THETA
11 SORORITY, INC., JACKSONVILLE ALUMNAE CHAPTER
12 ("JAC") FOR THE MAY WEEK PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM")
13 AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO
14 FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; AMENDING THE FIFTH
15 REVISED SCHEDULE M TO ORDINANCE 2024-511-E;
16 WAIVING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111
17 (CONTRACTS; CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION;
18 CARRYOVER), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE),
19 *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO EXEMPT THE SERVICES TO BE
20 PROVIDED BY JAC FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT;
21 APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER
22 DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR
23 THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF KHA TO EXECUTE
24 AND DELIVER AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF
25 JACKSONVILLE OR KHA AND DELTA SIGMA THETA
26 SORORITY, INC., JACKSONVILLE ALUMNAE CHAPTER FOR
27 THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY KHA;
28 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

30 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

31 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,

1 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
2 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
3 listed in subsection (b):

10 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

11 The funding above is an appropriation of \$15,000 from the
12 Special Council Contingency account to the Subsidies and
13 Contributions to Private Org account within the Kids Hope
14 Alliance ("KHA") Fund to provide funding to Delta Sigma
15 Theta Sorority, Inc., Jacksonville Alumnae Chapter ("JAC")
16 for the May Week Program (the "Program") as described
17 herein.

18 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
19 Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to JAC
20 for the Program as described in **Exhibit 2**, attached hereto and
21 incorporated herein by this reference. The Program is designed to
22 promote and expand youth development in Jacksonville by highlighting
23 academic and professional achievements while also offering events
24 that emphasize the importance of higher education, particularly for
25 black women. The events offered through the Program include
26 school-based community service campaigns and contests, youth
27 empowerment summits, financial aid workshops, mini seminars on
28 college preparedness and strategies for success, motivational videos,
29 career fairs, "hot topic" panel discussions, and "STEAMinars." The
30 City funds will support the Program by providing \$15,000 for college
31 scholarships, to be distributed in amounts of up to \$3,000 per

1 scholarship, to be awarded to high school seniors to assist with
2 their higher education expenses.

3 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated herein shall
4 not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

5 **Section 4. Amending the Fifth Revised Schedule M to**
6 **Ordinance 2024-511-E.** The Kids Hope Alliance fiscal year 2024-2025
7 budget approved by Ordinance 2024-511-E is hereby amended by
8 substituting in place of the Fifth Revised Schedule M, the Sixth
9 Revised Schedule M, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated
10 herein by this reference, to reflect the funds appropriated herein.

11 **Section 5. Waiving Certain Requirements of Section 77.111,**
12 **Ordinance Code.** The City hereby waives certain requirements of
13 Section 77.111 (Contracts; contract administration; carryover),
14 Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), *Ordinance Code*, with respect to the
15 contract with JAC approved and authorized by this Ordinance.
16 Specifically, subsection 77.111(a) requires Provider Contracts for
17 children's services provided by third parties to be competitively
18 procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed
19 in order to allow KHA to directly contract with Delta Sigma Theta
20 Sorority, Inc., Jacksonville Alumnae Chapter for the May Week Program
21 described in **Exhibit 2**.

22 **Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute.** There is
23 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation
24 Secretary, and/or the Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby
25 authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City or KHA, an
26 agreement with Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., Jacksonville Alumnae
27 Chapter, in an amount not-to-exceed \$15,000. The agreement shall be
28 subject to and administered in accordance with Chapter 77, *Ordinance*
29 *Code*, and the terms, scope and budget more particularly described in
30 **Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing on July 1, 2025 through December 31,
31 2025, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions,

1 renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all
2 action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject
3 to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or
4 his designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate
5 insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section
6 128.601, *Ordinance Code*.

7 **Section 7. Oversight Department.** The Kids Hope Alliance
8 shall oversee the project described herein.

9 **Section 8. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
10 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
11 without the Mayor's signature.
