9 PARKING; EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN OFFICIALS;
10 REGISTRY OF "PUBLIC OFFICIAL" SEALS; RENTING
11 OF PARKING METERS, EXEMPTIONS FOR VEHICLES
12 DISPLAYING DISABLED PLACARDS AND DISABLED
13 VETERANS LICENSE PLATES), CHAPTER 802 (PUBLIC
14 PARKING), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO UPDATE CITY
15 PARKING METER RENTAL (BAGGING) AND APPLICATION
16 FEES; AMENDING SECTION 802.107 (RATES AND
17 CHARGES ESTABLISHED FOR SPECIFIC ZONES),
18 CHAPTER 802 (PUBLIC PARKING), *ORDINANCE CODE*,
19 TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF
20 THE DIA, RATHER THAN THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
21 OFFICER, TO PERFORM THE FUNCTIONS AS SET FORTH
22 THEREIN; AMENDING CITY OF JACKSONVILLE FEES AT
23 [HTTP://WWW.COJ.NET/FEES](http://www.coj.net/fees) TO MODIFY THE OFFICE
24 OF PUBLIC PARKING METER RENTAL FEES; PROVIDING
25 FOR A DIRECTIVE TO THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES
26 DIVISION TO CIRCULATE ENACTED LEGISLATION TO
27 THE WEBMASTER FOR IMMEDIATE UPDATE OF FEES
28 ONLINE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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30 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

31 **Section 1. Amending City of Jacksonville Fees.** The City

1 of Jacksonville's fees which were directed by Ordinance 2017-665-E
2 to be published at <http://www.coj.net/fees> are hereby amended to
3 reflect the amended parking meter rental and application fees, as
4 indicated in **Exhibit 1** attached hereto and incorporated herein by
5 this reference.

6 **Section 2. Directive to Legislative Services Division.**

7 The Chief of the Legislative Services Division is hereby directed

11 **Section 3. Amending Chapter 802 (Public Parking), Section**
12 **802.107 (Rates and charges established for specific zones),**
13 **Ordinance Code.** Chapter 802 (Public Parking), Section 802.107 (Rates
14 and charges established for specific zones is hereby amended to
15 read as follows:

16 **CHAPTER 802**

17 * * *

18 **Sec. 802.107 Rates and charges established for specific zones.**

19 (a) The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Economic Development
20 Officer, in consultation with the Downtown Investment Authority
21 Chief Executive Officer, for Downtown zones pursuant to the
22 definition of Downtown in Chapter 55, Ordinance Code, shall develop
23 rates and charges for each parking meter zone, and the times and
24 days when these charges shall be enforced. Rates shall be designed
25 to provide for the most efficient use of on-street parking spaces,
26 to be competitive with off-street parking facilities, and to
27 achieve other downtown revitalization goals as determined by the
28 Downtown Investment Authority Office of Economic Development. The
29 CEO Economic Development Officer shall file the rate schedule and
30 any subsequent change to the rate schedule with the Council
31 Secretary, and such rates shall become effective upon such filing,

1 unless and until the Council enacts an ordinance to the contrary.

2 (b) The ~~CEO Economic Development Officer, in consultation with~~
3 ~~the Downtown Investment Authority Chief Executive Officer,~~ may
4 develop a discount program for on-street parking to encourage short
5 term parking in the downtown area. Such a discount program may
6 involve graduated rates, payment using smartcards which may be sold
7 at a discount, the waiving of parking citations under certain
8 conditions, and any other policy or program designed to improve the
9 perception, availability or value of on-street parking. The
10 ~~CEO Economic Development Officer~~ shall file any discount program and
11 any subsequent change to the discount rate program with the Council
12 Secretary, and such discounts shall become effective upon such
13 filing, unless and until the Council enacts an ordinance to the
14 contrary.

15 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
17 without the Mayor's signature.
