7 A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING GUSTAVO
8 GUZMAN FOR HIS RECEIPT OF THE 2024 JACKSONVILLE
9 TEACHER OF THE YEAR AWARD AND FOR HIS
10 CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE TERRY PARKER COMMUNITY;
11 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 **WHEREAS,** Gustavo Guzman, a third-year biology teacher at Terry
14 Parker High School, has been recognized for his energy, commitment,
15 and effectiveness as an educator, empowering students with positive
16 affirmations based on character development, academic growth, and
17 athletic accomplishments; and

18 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Guzman, the son of agricultural laborers and a
19 first-generation college graduate who graduated Magna Cum Laude from
20 Edward Waters University, alumni member of the Delta Psi Chapter of
21 Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., is currently working on a master's
22 degree in education public policy, and serves as the site director
23 for the 5000 Role Models of Excellence program assisting minority
24 male youth by providing positive role models and mentors; and

25 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Guzman's effectiveness in the classroom is
26 demonstrated in the material success of his students, as one of his
27 classes increased their test scores by 22% during the 2022-2023 school
28 year; and

29 **WHEREAS,** During the 33rd Annual EDDY Awards, Gustavo Guzman has
30 been named the 2024 VyStar Duval County Teacher of the Year, having
31 been selected by a committee of volunteers from a cadre of exceptional

1 educators throughout Duval County; and

2 **WHEREAS,** for his victory, Mr. Guzman will receive a cash prize
3 and classroom grant, serve as an ex-officio member on the Jacksonville
4 Public Education Fund Board of Directors, and will be considered for
5 Florida Teacher of the Year in July alongside other exceptionally
6 effective teachers throughout the state; now therefore

7 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

8 **Section 1.** The City Council hereby honors and commends
9 Gustavo Guzman for being named the 2024 Duval County Teacher of the
10 Year and for his commitment to the success of the students of Terry
11 Parker High School and the Duval County Public Schools system. The
12 City Council recognizes the vital role that teachers play in our
13 community, with Mr. Guzman standing out among them as an inspirational
14 role model for his students. The City Council extends its
15 congratulations to Mr. Guzman on receiving this honor and commends
16 him and his students for the hard work that they continue to
17 exemplify. The Council extends best wishes for the continued success
18 of Mr. Guzman, his students, and Terry Parker High School.
