7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$193,428, WITH NO  
8 LOCAL MATCH, FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF  
9 LAW ENFORCEMENT FOR THE NATIONAL CRIME  
10 STATISTICS EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD  
11 APRIL 30, 2020, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30,2021, AS  
12 INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 20-107; APPROVING  
13 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE,  
14 AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND  
15 DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY THE CERTIFICATE  
16 OF SUBAWARD AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL  
17 FUNDING ASSISTANCE BETWEEN THE FLORIDA  
18 DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AND THE CITY OF  
19 JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY JSO;  
20 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
25 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
26 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

29 NSCPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference)

4 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

5 The funding above is from the Florida Department of Law  
6 Enforcement for the National Crime Statistics Exchange  
7 Program for the period April 30, 2020, through September  
8 30,2021. No local match is required.

9 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
10 Section 1 is to assist the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO) with  
11 meeting the January 2021 deadline to submit crime data to the  
12 Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and, subsequently, to  
13 the FBI. The project includes analysis, the creation of the  
14 required data elements, and test submissions to FDLE. This one-  
15 time transition does not warrant additional full-time positions;  
16 thus, JSO is proposing the use of a procurement contract for  
17 temporary staff augmentation. Under the procurement contract, two  
18 individuals will perform work over a nine month period to: 1)  
19 conduct an analysis; 2) extract/build the necessary data elements  
20 into the Records Management System (RMS); and, 3) complete test  
21 submissions.

22 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby  
23 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation  
24 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of  
25 the City the Certificate of Subaward and the Acceptance of Federal  
26 Funding Assistance between the City and FDLE, in substantially the  
27 same forms attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as  
28 "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised Forms, September 14, 2020 - NCSPHS" and  
29 incorporated herein by this reference.

30 **Section 4. Oversight.** JSO shall oversee the Program.

31 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become

1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
2 without the Mayor's signature.
