Bill Summary: This bill confirms the appointment of Martha Moore, P.E. as a member of the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) to the Concurrency & Mobility Management System Office, for a non-consecutive third full-term ending June 30, 2026.

Background Information: The TAC to the Concurrency and Mobility Management Systems Office is established pursuant to Chapter 655, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to assist in the development of an updated Concurrency and Mobility Management System Handbook and serve as technical advisors in appeals of concurrency and mobility decisions.

Section 655.122(b), *Ordinance Code*, provides that the membership of the committee shall include three licensed professional traffic engineers appointed by the President of the City Council.

Ms. Moore holds bachelor's degrees from Georgia Institute of Technology and Jacksonville University. She is a professional engineer registered in the states of Florida and Georgia. Ms. Moore works for Alfred Benesch & Co. She resides in Duval County in council district 2.
