**Type of Action:** Memorandum of Understanding; Provides for oversight

**Bill Summary:** This bill authorizes the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary to execute and deliver a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Jacksonville and the City of Neptune Beach to assist the City of Neptune Beach with the management of disaster debris. The bill provides for oversight by the Public Works Department.

**Background Information:** The Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Jacksonville and the City of Neptune Beach allows the City to assist Neptune Beach with its management of debris from major disasters. Under the MOU, Neptune Beach may use the City's landfill on Girvin Road for staging, sorting, processing, and temporarily storing eligible disaster debris in accordance with applicable FEMA Public Assistance Program and Policy Guide requirements, environmental regulations, and local ordinances. Hazardous materials, prohibited waste, and non-disaster related debris will not be accepted without the City's prior written approval.
