5 A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING ROSEMARY
6 WESOLOWSKI UPON HER RETIREMENT AFTER TWENTY
7 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE TO THE CITY OF
8 JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 **WHEREAS**, Rosemary Wesolowski retired on July 11, 2025, after
11 faithfully serving the City of Jacksonville for twenty years,
12 beginning her tenure on April 11, 2005, as a Human Services Planner
13 II, advancing to Human Services Planner III, and culminating in her
14 role as Senior Neighborhoods Services Coordinator within the
15 Neighborhoods Department; and

16 **WHEREAS**, during her distinguished career, Ms. Wesolowski made
17 significant contributions to improving the quality of life in
18 Jacksonville's neighborhoods, providing guidance, resources, and
19 support to residents and the community; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Wesolowski played a key role in supporting the
21 Southeast Citizens Planning Advisory Committee (CPAC), where she
22 facilitated more than 500 meetings between 2005 and 2025, contributed
23 to the successful 2025 Neighborhoods, USA (NUSA) Conference in
24 Jacksonville, and provided annual CommUniverCity training to prepare
25 neighborhoods' leaders to advocate for their communities; and

26 **WHEREAS**, she also organized and participated in a wide range of
27 community initiatives, including association creation, clean-ups, and
28 back-to-school programs, and earned the Historic Preservation Project
29 Award from the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission for her
30 work, along with Old Arlington Inc., on the 60th Anniversary of the
31 Mathews Bridge Celebration, and supported and staffed the

1 Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission from 2011
2 to 2016; and

3 **WHEREAS**, she earned her Bachelor's degree from the University
4 of North Florida, reflecting her dedication to excellence and the
5 strong foundation she brought to her two decades of service with the
6 City of Jacksonville; and

7 **WHEREAS**, she has been recognized for her strong commitment to
8 public service, professionalism, and the positive relationships she
9 built with residents, colleagues, and community partners; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Wesolowski's dedication, institutional knowledge,
11 and tireless advocacy for Jacksonville's neighborhoods have left a
12 lasting impact that will benefit the community for years to come; now
13 therefore

14 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1.** The City Council hereby honors and commends
16 Rosemary Wesolowski for her twenty years of dedicated service to the
17 City and extends its best wishes in her retirement.

18 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
20 without the Mayor's signature.
