Bill Summary: The bill amends the 2026-2030 Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2025-505-E to revise the scope of the “Fire Station 18” project to eliminate property acquisition and parking expansion and add exterior elements to improve aesthetics and safety.

Background Information: The purpose of amending the 2026-2030 Capital Improvement Plan is to revise the scope of the project entitled “Fire Station 18” (Project # 004312). The original scope of work included the acquisition of property to the north of the fire station, site clearing and incorporating the land into the station's footprint. Evaluations have determined the property acquisition and parking expansion are no longer feasible within the current budget and timeline. The updated scope will eliminate property acquisition and parking expansion and add an art mural, landscaping improvements, and exterior lighting. These additions are intended to enhance the station's exterior appearance, integrate it with the surrounding community, and improve safety.

Fiscal Impact: No cost to the City. Only revises the scope of the project.
