Bill Summary: This bill closes and abandons an unopened and unimproved portion of right-of-way established in the Jacksonville Farms Plat, as recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 41 of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 8. There were no objections by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the right-of-way.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to permit the applicant who owns the property adjacent to the closure area at 148 Halsema Road North (William M. Pippin Jr.) to construct a home on his property and a driveway to his garage.

Policy Impact Area: Closure/Abandonment of Right-of-Way near 148 Halsema Road North

Fiscal Impact: Applicant paid \$2,091 closure application fee
