5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$3,950 FROM THE
6 NATIONAL ARTS PROGRAM - CONTRIBUTIONS FROM
7 PRIVATE SOURCES ACCOUNT (\$3,450) AND THE
8 MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES AND CHARGES ACCOUNT
9 (\$500) TO THE MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS AND AIDS
10 ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE \$3,450 TO BE DISTRIBUTED AS
11 AWARDS AND \$500 FOR A RECEPTION HONORING THE
12 AWARD RECIPIENTS IN A LOCAL ART SHOW FEATURING
13 ART CREATED BY CITY OF JACKSONVILLE EMPLOYEES OR
14 A MEMBER OF THEIR IMMEDIATE FAMILY; PROVIDING AN
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2025-2026 fiscal year,
19 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
21 listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

29 The funding above is an appropriation of \$3,950 from the
30 National Awards Program - Contributions From Private
31 Sources account to the Miscellaneous Grants and Aids

1 account (\$3,450) and the Miscellaneous Services and Charges
2 account (\$500) to provide \$3,450 for awards and \$500 for a
3 reception honoring the award recipients in a local National
4 Arts Program art show featuring art created by City of
5 Jacksonville employees or a member of their immediate
6 family.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
8 Section 1 is to utilize funding from the National Arts Program to be
9 distributed as awards in a local art show and to offset costs for a
10 reception exhibiting the art and honoring the award recipients. The
11 National Arts Program supports artists of all mediums at the local
12 level by providing advertising and promotional materials and funding
13 to support the creation and recognition of visual art. Local artists
14 comprised of City of Jacksonville employees, or a member of their
15 immediate family, will submit art in one of the following five
16 classifications: (1) professional, (2) intermediate, (3) amateur, (4)
17 teen 13-18 years of age, and (5) youth 12 years and under. The art
18 will be judged by local professionals in the visual arts field. First
19 place, second place, and third place award winners in the
20 professional, intermediate, and amateur classifications will receive
21 \$350, \$250, and \$150, respectively while first, second, and third
22 place winners in the teen and youth classifications will receive
23 \$150, \$100, and \$50, respectively. In addition, one artist will
24 receive a "Best of Show" award in the amount of \$400 and one artist
25 will receive an "Art Education Award" in the amount of \$200. The
26 Council President will host a reception where the art will be
27 exhibited for public view and to honor the award recipients.

28 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
29 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
30 without the Mayor's signature.
