> The funding above is an appropriation of \$2,532,308.00 from the City's General Fund - General Service District fund balance recaptured from fiscal year 2019-2020 close out of the KHA operating funds to provide KHA Out-of-School Time learning recovery programming for students impacted by COVID-19 and to correct a 2017 accounting error that resulted in a deficit in the KHA SAMHSA High-Fidelity Wraparound Services and Integrated Care Coordination for Children and Youth Program grant fund.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer \$724,786.00 in recaptured City General Fund - General Service District fund balance to correct an accounting error that resulted in a deficit in the KHA SAMHSA High-Fidelity Wraparound Services and Integrated Care Coordination for Children and Youth Program grant fund. This transfer will bring this account to a zero balance, allowing the grant to be closed. The remaining \$1,807,522.00 in recaptured funds will be used to provide expanded KHA Out-of-School Time learning opportunities through afterschool, summer and learning recovery programs for students impacted by COVID-19, as shown on the 8th Revised Schedule M, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2021-2022.
