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ORDINANCE 2024-172

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT A DONATION FROM THE PLACEMAKING AND EQUITY FUND, INC. FOR THE ENHANCEMENT OF LIFT EV'RY VOICE AND SING PARK (THE "PARK") IN THE AMOUNT OF \$868,506.00, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 111.105(B), ORDINANCE DONATION WHICH REQUIRES AT \$125,000.00 TO BE DEDICATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION A MIST FOUNTAIN, \$228,000.00 FOR STAGE CONSTRUCTION AND THE REMAINDER TO BE EXPENDED ON GENERAL ENHANCEMENT OF THE LIFT EV'RY VOICE AND SING PARK (THE "PROJECT"); APPROPRIATING \$868,506.00 FROM PROD OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR -PARKS AND RECREATION CONTRIBUTIONS FROM PRIVATE SOURCE TO THE CIP PROJECT ENTITLED "PARKS QOL -LIFT EVE'RY VOICE AND SING PARK" (THE "PROJECT") FOR ENHANCEMENTS TO THE PARK; AMENDING THE 2024-2028 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED ORDINANCE 2023-505-E TO REFLECT APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Placemaking and Equity Fund, Inc., in partnership with Everbank, NA, Jacksonville Transportation Authority, the Jacksonville Jaguars Foundation, and the Jessie Ball duPont Fund, have generously offered to donate \$868,506.00 for the enhancement of

Lift Ev'ry Voice and Sing Park (the "Park"), located in the historic LaVilla neighborhood, Downtown Jacksonville, at 176 Lee Street North between W. Adams and Houston Streets, in Council District 7; and

WHEREAS, the Park honors two of Jacksonville's most famous residents, James Weldon Johnson and John Rosamond Johnson, who cowrote "Lift Ev'ry Voice and Sing," often called the "Black National Anthem," at their home, which was once located on the site that is now the Park; and

WHEREAS, this Park will be a destination for residents and visitors to learn about "Lift Ev'ry Voice and Sing" and LaVilla's dynamic history and to participate in engaging programs and activities; and

whereas, this donation is intended to contribute to the overall enhancement of the Park; however, the donors request at least \$125,000.00 be spent on the construction of the mist fountain and \$228,000.00 be spent on the construction of the stage, with the balance available for overall enhancement to the Park; and

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department desires to accept this donation of funds for enhancement of the Park and is seeking City Council approval of the donation in accordance with Section 111.105(b), Ordinance Code; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Recognizing Gift. The City Council hereby approves, and authorizes the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department Director ("Director") to accept and expend the generous donation from the Placemaking and Equity Fund, Inc., in the amount of \$868,506.00 for the enhancement of Lift Ev'ry Voice and Sing Park, and specifically directing \$125,000.00 to be expended on the construction of the mist fountain, and \$228,000.00 to be expended on the stage construction, in accordance with Section 111.105(b), Ordinance Code.

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Section 2. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2 is to provide funding for enhancements at Lift Ev'ry Voice and Sing Park. Specifically, \$125,000.00 of the funds shall be used for the construction of the mist fountain, and \$228,000.00 shall be used for the construction of the stage, with the remainder of the funds for general enhancement of the Park.

Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2023-505-E. In all other respects, the

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Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2023-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
