RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") DELIVER THE 5TH STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT AS A LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM (LAP) PROJECT TO PROVIDE GREATER EFFICIENCY, INNOVATION, AND COST SAVINGS TO THECITY; ENDORSING THEPRELIMINARY DEVELOPMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT BY THE FDOT THAT INCLUDES THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT (NEPA) ACTIVITIES; ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATED ACCEPTANCE OF ADDITIONAL ACQUIRED RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE 5TH STREET BRIDGE NUMBER 724039 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT SHOULD IT BE NEEDED FOR FURTHERANCE OF ITS FINANCIAL PROJECT NO. 437414-1 IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 10; AUTHORIZING A SEPARATE TRANSFER AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT FOR THE SUBJECT PROJECT AT A LATER DATE IF ADDITIONAL RIGHT-OF-WAY WILL BE REQUIRED FOR THE COMPLETION OF THIS PROJECT; PROVIDING THAT ANY ITEMS, IN FDOT'S SOLE DISCRETION AND THE WITHOUT LIMITATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS (CFR), DEEMED TO BE FEDERAL NON-PARTICIPATING ITEMS SHALL BE FOUNDED AT THE EXPENSE OF THE FDOT; PROVIDING SOLE FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC

WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council:

Endorsing FDOT Financial Project No. 437414-1 to Section 1. be performed as a Local Agency Program project and Approving and Accepting Right-of-Way. The City of Jacksonville endorses the delivery of the Financial Project No. 437414-1 (the "Project") in Council District 10 as a Local Agency Program (LAP) project to allow for greater efficiency, innovation, and cost savings to the city, and requests that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) provide the Preliminary Development and Environmental assessment that includes the National Environmental Policy Act activities. The City of Jacksonville will accept additional acquired right-of-way for the Project should it be needed for Project completion. If additional Right-of-Way is required for completion of the Project, the FDOT and the City of Jacksonville will execute a separate transfer and maintenance agreement for that Right-of-Way at a later date. Also, any items, in the FDOT's sole discretion and without limitation in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations, deemed to be federal non-participating items, shall be funded at the sole expense for the FDOT.

Section 2. Execution of Documents Authorized. The Mayor and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute all documents which will facilitate the acceptance of the Right-of-Way for 5th Street Bridge Number 724039.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
