AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A LETTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND CENTURION OF FLORIDA, LLC FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF AUTOPSY SERVICES PERFORMED FOR THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (FDOC) AT FACILITIES IN FDOC REGION 2, FOR WHICH THE DISTRICT IV MEDICAL EXAMINER'S OFFICE HAS JURISDICTION; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE MEDICAL EXAMINER'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 406, Florida Statutes, the District IV Medical Examiner provides medical services to Centurion of Florida, LLC in the form of autopsy services to the Florida Department of Corrections (FDOC) facilities in FDOC Region 2, for which the District IV Medical Examiner's Office has jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Letter of Agreement ("LOA"), Centurion of Florida, LLC will reimburse the District IV Medical Examiner for these services in accordance with the Compensation Schedule attached to the LOA; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, a Letter of Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Centurion of Florida, LLC, in substantially the same form as is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, and all other documents

necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance and said LOA. The term of the LOA shall be for a five (5) year period commencing on October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2028. Reimbursement from Centurion of Florida, LLC for services provided by the District IV Medical Examiner shall be in accordance with the Compensation Schedule attached to the LOA. This Compensation (Fee) Schedule was approved by the City Council pursuant to Ordinance 2017-370-E, as required by Section 124.103, Ordinance Code.

Section 2. Oversight. The Medical Examiner's Office shall oversee administration of the Letter of Agreement.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
