Contract 20399 provides for the removal of a white 21' vessel in the state waters of Julington Creek, northeast of Clarks Reg: Unknown, and a green 21' vessel at Mandarin Point in the St. Johns River, south of the Buckman Bridge Reg: Unknown. Contract 21034 provides for the removal of a 38' white Bayliner Cabin Cruiser, in Broward River behind 1223 Cedar Bay Road, Reg: FL3690NV. Once removed, the vessels will be taken to an authorized landfill for disposal. EQD will subcontract the removal and disposal based upon lowest bids.
