Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$25,000 grant award from Florida Animal Friend, Inc., as initiated by B.T. 20-021; approves and authorizes the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Grant Award Agreement between the City and Florida Animal Friend, Inc.; and provides for oversight by the Animal Care and Protective Services.

Background Information: Florida Animal Friend, Inc., primary goal is to help end pet overpopulation. The mission is to help save the lives of countless unwanted cats and dogs by supporting organizations that offer free or low-cost spay and neuter services across the state of Florida. The award will fund spay and neuter services to feral and free-roaming cats and kittens within the community.
