



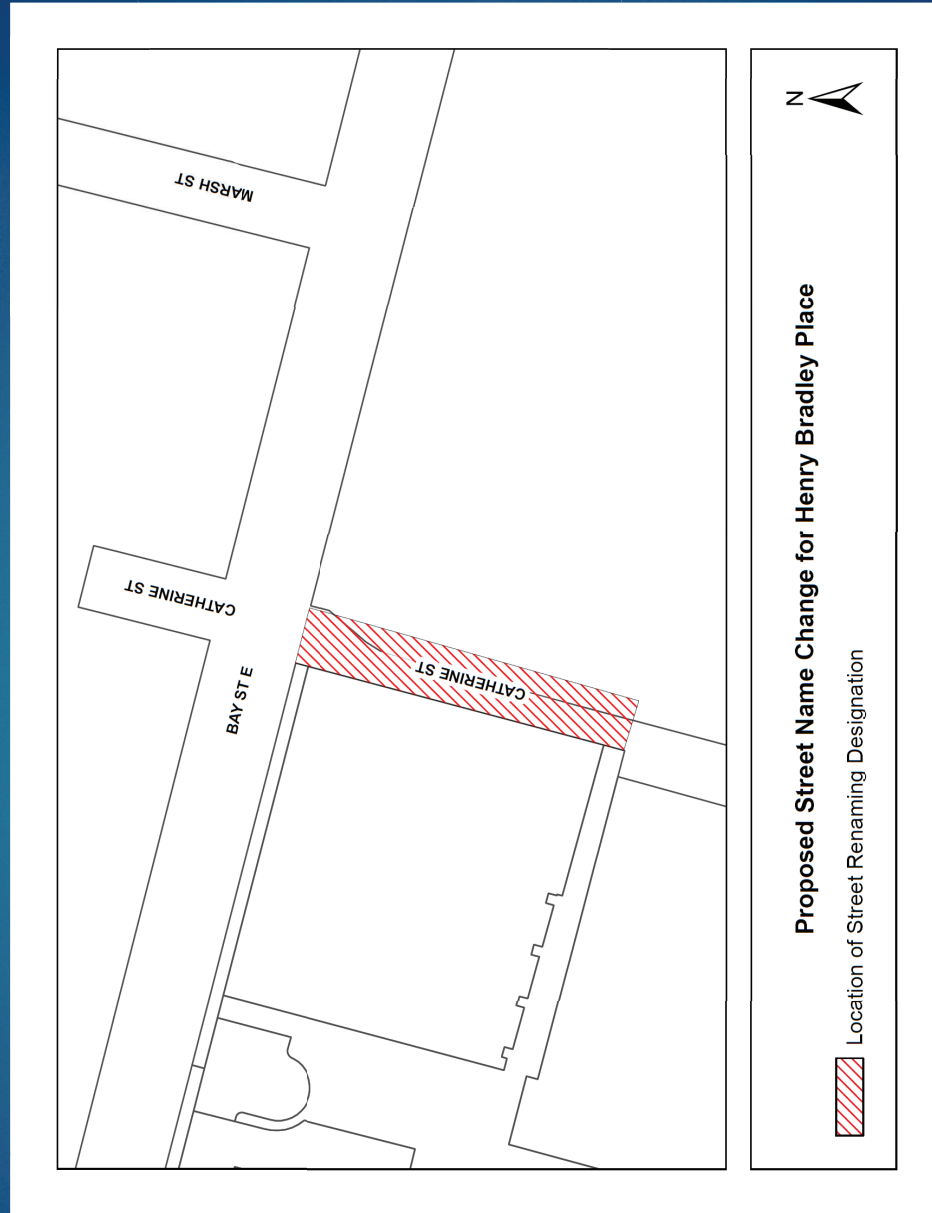
Catherine Street to Henry Bradley Place – Street Renaming

NEW PROPOSAL TO COMMITTEE FOR PUBLIC STREET NAME CHANGE

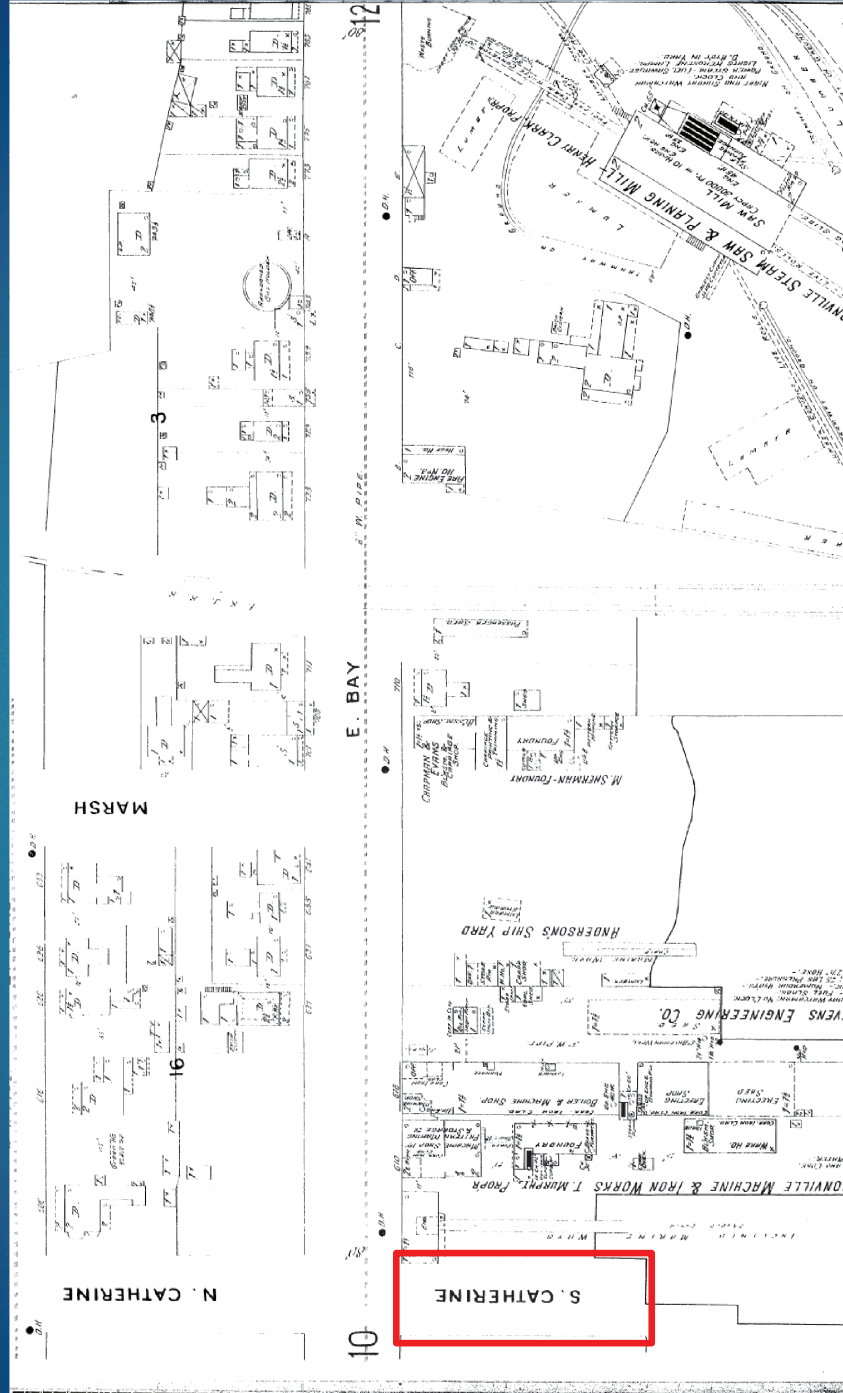
Background

- ▲ Henry Bradley was the first firefighter to die in the line of duty on December 16th, 1885.
- ▲ Proposal will rename a portion of Catherine Street to Henry Bradley Place.
- ▲ Proposal will rename the relocated fire museum to Henry Bradley Firefighters Museum
- ▲ New proposed name:
 - ▲ **Henry Bradley Place**

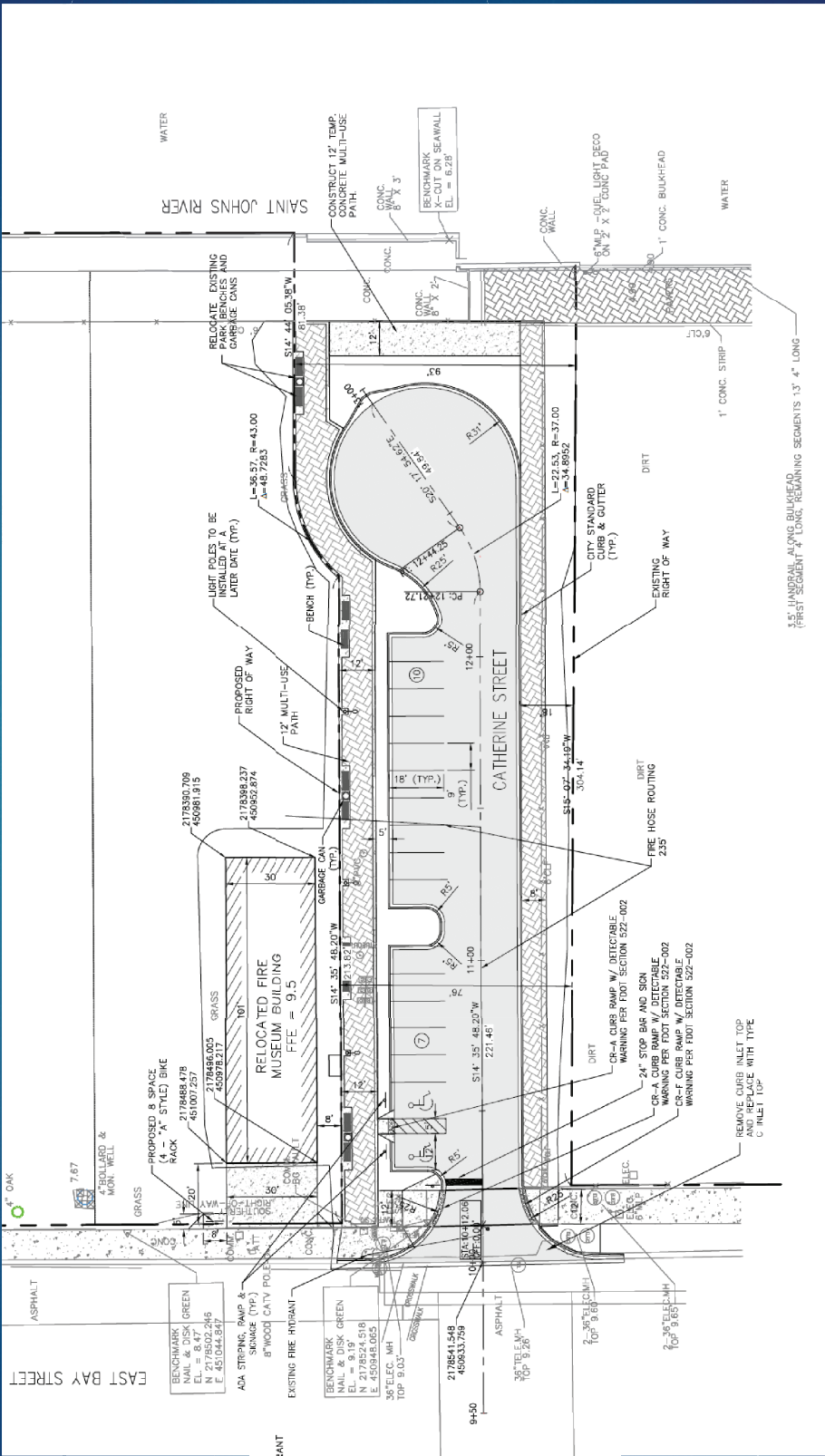
Extent: Sanborne Map 1897



Affected Property/Entity Owners:

- ▶ Currently there are no properties or structures addressed from this portion of Catherine Street.
- ▶ Relocation of the fire museum to the southeast corner of Bay Street East and Catherine Street per CDN#: 616.338 from 1406 Gator Bowl Blvd.
 - ▶ Fire Museum addressed as: 620 Bay St E
 - ▶ Should a new address for the Museum be established for the renaming of the street and the Museum itself?
 - ▶ Example: 1 Henry Bradley Place (if approved).
 - ▶ Fire museum fronts Bay St E.
- ▶ USS Orleck Museum sits at the end of this portion of Catherine Street.
 - ▶ Currently addressed as 610 Bay St E
 - ▶ Only accessible via the portion of road proposing to be renamed.
