**ORDINANCE 2025-109-E**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$912,681.48,  
INCLUDING \$629,436.20 IN REVENUE COLLECTED FROM  
THE FORECLOSURE REGISTRY, A REALLOCATION OF  
PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF  
\$281,866.63, AND A BUDGETARY ADJUSTMENT TO  
CORRECT REVENUE BALANCES IN THE AMOUNT OF  
\$1,378.65, TO FUND VARIOUS PROGRAMS AND  
ACTIVITIES AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 179,  
*ORDINANCE CODE*, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-038;  
AUTHORIZING POSITIONS, AS INITIATED BY R.C.  
25-062; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,  
within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated

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(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above comprises \$629,436.20 in revenue  
collected from the Foreclosure Registry, a reallocation of

1 previously appropriated funds in the amount of \$281,866.63,  
2 and a budgetary adjustment to correct revenue balances in  
3 the amount of \$1,378.65, to fund various programs and  
4 activities authorized pursuant to Chapter 179, *Ordinance*  
5 *Code*.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
7 Section 1 is to provide funding for various programs and activities  
8 authorized pursuant to Chapter 179, *Ordinance Code*. The funds are  
9 collected from mortgages on properties that are in default.

10 **Section 3. Approval of Positions.** There are hereby  
11 approved the positions more fully described in R.C. 25-062, attached  
12 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

13 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
15 without the Mayor's signature.
