Bill Summary: The bill provides the City's prioritized recommendations to the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) for federally assisted transportation projects for 2024.

Background Information: The NFTPO is the transportation planning agency for the 4-county Northeast Florida region and is responsible for annually prioritizing projects in the region for which federal transportation funding is being sought. Project funding comes from a variety of use-specific federal and state funds and is shared among the 4 counties of the Northeast Florida region (Clay, St. Johns, Nassau, Jacksonville) on a proportional basis according to population. Jacksonville's list contains a total of 48 projects. The number of projects by category is as follows:

- Roadway Capacity Improvements: 23 projects (5 new, 8 previously funded)
- Tie-in to Resurfacing Projects: 4 projects (1 previously funded)
- Sun Trails Projects: 4 projects (1 new multi-segment urban project)
- FDOT/TAP (Transportation Alternative Program) Projects: 10 projects (none new)
- FDOT/TAP SR2S (Safe Routes to School) Projects 7 projects (all new)
