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ORDINANCE 2024-556

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) ORDINANCE CODE; ESTABLISHING AN HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION AND ASSOCIATED ROADWAY MARKERS FOR ERMA LEE COLE; ESTABLISHING AN HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION ON BROADWAY AVENUE EXTENDING BETWEEN BAKER AVENUE AND ROBINSON AVENUE IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 9 FOR ERMA LEE COLE; PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TWO HONORARY ROADWAY MARKERS TO BE LOCATED IN APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS ON THE DESIGNATED ROAD IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 9; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT OF SUBSECTION 745.105 (I)(2), ORDINANCE CODE, THAT THE HONOREE BE DECEASED FOR AT LEAST FIVE YEARS; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, ADDRESSING DIVISION FOR PROCESSING, IMPLEMENTATION AND COORDINATION WITH THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, TRAFFIC ENGINEERING AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Erma Lee Cole, having lived in the same home in Jacksonville since her birth, passed away in 2023; and

WHEREAS, Erma Lee Cole was a proud graduate of Old Stanton High School and the former Beaumont School of Nursing; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Cole volunteered, without end, in the Jacksonville community namely being the catalyst for construction of an overpass

 at the Coastline Railroad which intersects Broadway and McQuade Streets; and

WHEREAS, the overpass was extremely important in the community because it provided a safe route for children walking to and from school; and

WHEREAS, in the early 1970's, Erma Lee Cole help create "Health Happening" programs which provided free medical services to thousands of residents in the community; and

WHEREAS, the "Health Happening" medical programs provided eye screening, tuberculosis screening, blood pressure and diabetes testing; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Erma Lee Cole was steadfast in obtaining a grant in 1998 which assisted with applying new paint to the homes of elderly homeowners; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Cole also provided transportation to residents for medical appointments, Social Security, community cleanups and "National Night Out"; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Cole ensured the safety of the community by requesting the installation of 120 streetlights in Jacksonville which also included vision meetings; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Cole received several awards: 1999 Mayor's Senior Lifetime Achievement Award, 1998 Good Neighbor Award, 1998 Volunteer of the Year Award from the Boys and Girls Club and the 1999 Brighten Our Neighborhood award; and

WHEREAS, Erma Lee Cole also volunteered as a member of numerous civic organizations including the President of the Robinson's Addition Neighborhood Association, Block Captain, Legal Aid, Neighborhood Leadership Counsil, Greater Jacksonville Economic Organization, Council on Elder Affairs, Northwest CPAC, Sheriff's Advisory Council, Women's Health Initiative, Jacksonville Housing Partnership, National Welfare Rights Organization and the Weed and

WHEREAS, Erma Lee Cole was active in her church, Ephesus Seventh Day Adventist Church. There, she held several office positions, served on the Missing Members Committee, Home and Leader, Assistant to the Women's Ministry Leader, New Sanctuary Choir, True 'N' Hearts Club and the Jaye Chalameers musical group; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Cole donated several computers to Ephesus Junior Academy computer lab in memory of her deceased son. She also donated microphones for the church choir; and

WHEREAS, the applicant submitted an Application and the required fee for the honorary marker. A copy of the application and the payment invoice are attached, respectively, as Exhibits 1 and 2; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 745.105 (j) (10), Ordinance Code, the Planning and Development Department mailed written notifications on April 15, 2024, and on May 15, 2024, to nineteen (19) affected property owners requesting their written consent or objection to the proposed honorary street designation. A copy of the first and second written notifications and a complete listing of the 19 total affected addresses are attached, respectively, as Exhibits 3, 4 and 5; and

WHEREAS, one (1) property owner returned the form as blank. A copy of the blank form is attached as Exhibit 6; and

WHEREAS, three (3) mailings were "returned to sender." A copy
of the "returned to sender" forms are attached as Exhibit 7; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 745.105 (j)(10), Ord. Code, the remaining 15 affected property owners are deemed to have consented to the proposed honorary designations due to their non-response to the written notifications; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Broadway Avenue to receive an honorary street designation for "Erma Lee Cole" extending from Baker Avenue to Robinson Avenue in Council District 9, is hereby designated as

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contemplated by Section 745.105, Ordinance Code, for "Erma Lee Cole" A map of the road designation is attached hereto as Exhibit 8.

Section 2. Honorary Roadside Markers for "Erma Lee Cole" to be installed. Two honorary roadside markers, as contemplated by Section 745.105, Ordinance Code, recognizing "Erma Lee Cole" shall be placed in appropriate locations on Broadway Avenue.

Waiver of Subsection 745.105(i)(2), Ordinance Section 3. Code. Subsection 745.105(i)(2), Ordinance Code, requiring that the honoree be deceased for at least five years is hereby waived because the Council desires to recognize the extensive accomplishments and contributions that Erma Lee Cole made to the city of Jacksonville and within a more timely manner after her passing.

Section 4. Directing Legislative Services Division forward a copy to the Planning and Development Department. The Chief of Legislative Services is requested to send a copy of this legislation, once enacted, to the Planning and Development Department, Addressing Unit, for processing, implementation, and coordination with the Public Works Department, Traffic Engineering Division, the applicant and other affected agencies and organizations.

Effective Date. This Section 5. ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
