**Introducer/Sponsor(s):** Council Vice President pursuant to Section 84.303, *Ordinance Code*, and at the request of the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee

**Type of Action:** Establishment of grant categories

**Bill Summary:** This bill establishes the allocation of funding percentages for the Opioid Settlement Proceeds funded categories and the process of selecting recipients of Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants for Fiscal Year 2026-2027.

**Background Information:** For FY 26-27, the percentage allocations for the Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants will be: Prevention 34%; Treatment 33%; Recovery Support 33 %. The process of selecting recipients of Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 shall be the grant application process outlined in Chapter 84, *Ordinance Code*.
