## ORDINANCE 2022-367-E

ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN BEN'S PLACE SERVICES, INC. ("TENANT") AND THE CITY OF **JACKSONVILLE** ("LANDLORD") FOR USE OF THE NORMANDY COMMUNITY CENTER, LOCATED AT1751 LINDSEY JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32221; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; FINDING THAT CONTRACTUAL SERVICES ARE EXEMPT FROM COMPETITIVE PURSUANT SOLICITATION TO SECTION 126.107 (EXEMPTIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. License Agreement Approved and Execution Authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a License Agreement between Ben's Place Services, Inc. City ("tenant") and of Jacksonville ("landlord"), the substantially the form placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services (the "Lease"). Said Lease is for use of the Normandy

Community Center, located at 1751 Lindsey Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32221 to provide for and support the independence of individuals with disabilities.

Section 2. Finding that License Agreement is exempt from competitive solicitation under Section 126.107 (Exemptions), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code. Certain contractual and professional services are exempt from competitive solicitation pursuant to Section 126.107, Ordinance Code. In this case, the Council finds that the License Agreement falls within two exempt categories: services provided to persons with mental or physical disabilities (subsection (d)) and services to be provided by those prescribed in authorizing legislation (subsection (g)). Accordingly, the License Agreement herein approved is not subject to competitive solicitation.

Section 3. Oversight Department. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department shall oversee administration of the Lease described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
